- FOR the purpose of allowing a subtraction modification under the Maryland income tax for up to a certain amount of sales and use tax paid for the purchase of certain computer equipment during a certain period of time that is used by certain individuals; defining a certain term; making this Act an emergency measure; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to a Maryland income tax subtraction modification for the sales and use tax paid for the purchase of certain computer equipment.

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 6 (2) FOR A TAXABLE YEAR BEGINNING AFTER DECEMBER 31, 2019, 7 BUT BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2022, THE SUBTRACTION ALLOWED UNDER SUBSECTION 8 (A) OF THIS SECTION INCLUDES UP TO \$180 OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SALES AND 9 USE TAX PAID FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTER EQUIPMENT ON OR AFTER MARCH 1, 2020, BUT BEFORE JUNE 30, 2021, IF THE COMPUTER EQUIPMENT IS USED BY:
- 11 (I) STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN DISTANCE OR REMOTE 12 LEARNING, REGARDLESS OF EDUCATION LEVEL; OR
- 13 (II) INDIVIDUALS WHO WORK REMOTELY.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through June 30, 2022, and, at the end of June 30, 2022, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
