- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

13(II) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF LAW14DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION SCHOLARS.

15 (5) "UB LAW AND HBCU COOPERATIVE" MEANS THE UNIVERSITY 16 OF BALTIMORE SCHOOL OF LAW AND HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND 17 UNIVERSITIES STUDENT PIPELINE COOPERATIVE.

18 (B) THERE IS A LEGAL EDUCATION SUCCESS COLLABORATIVE BETWEEN 19 THE UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE SCHOOL OF LAW, THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND 20 SCHOOL OF LAW, AND THE MARYLAND HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND 21 UNIVERSITIES.

22 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE COLLABORATIVE IS TO INCREASE DIVERSITY IN 23 THE LEGAL FIELD THROUGH:

(1) FINANCIAL SUPPORT, ACADEMIC SUCCESS, PROFESSIONAL
 DEVELOPMENT, AND MENTORING OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS PARTICIPATING
 IN THE SCHOLARS PROGRAM;

27 (2) THE UB LAW AND HBCU COOPERATIVE THAT PREPARES 28 MARYLAND HBCU STUDENTS FOR LAW SCHOOL AND PROVIDES ACADEMIC 29 SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE TO STUDENTS IN LAW SCHOOL AND THROUGHOUT THEIR

2 (3) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF LAW DIVERSITY 3 AND INCLUSION SCHOLARS PROGRAM.

4 (D) (1) THE UB LAW AND HBCU COOPERATIVE SHALL BE DEVELOPED 5 AND ADMINISTERED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE SCHOOL OF LAW AND 6 COORDINATED WITH MARYLAND HBCUS.

7 (2) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF LAW DIVERSITY
8 AND INCLUSION SCHOLARS PROGRAM SHALL BE DEVELOPED AND ADMINISTERED
9 BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF LAW.

10 (E) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 11 GOVERNOR SHALL APPROPRIATE:

12 (1) \$200,000 TO EACH SCHOLARS PROGRAM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF 13 BALTIMORE SCHOOL OF LAW AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF 14 LAW; AND

15 (2) \$50,000 TO ONE MARYLAND HBCU SELECTED BY THE 16 MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION FOR SUPPORTING A COORDINATOR 17 POSITION TO PROMOTE THE SCHOLARS PROGRAM TO STUDENTS AT ALL MARYLAND 18 HBCUS.

19 (F) THE MONEY APPROPRIATED UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION 20 IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT FUNDING THAT WOULD OTHERWISE 21 BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE SCHOLARS PROGRAM, MARYLAND HBCUS, THE 22 UNIVERSITY OF BALTIMORE, OR THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, BALTIMORE 23 CAMPUS.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 25 1, 2021.
