### Baltimore City - West North Avenue Development Authority

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the West North Avenue Development Authority in 4 Baltimore City; providing for the composition ehair, and staffing and chair of the 5 Authority; authorizing the Authority to manage certain funds; prohibiting a member 6 of the Authority from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the 7 reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Authority to support and develop 8 a certain neighborhood revitalization plan in coordination with certain residents; 9 authorizing the Authority to modify certain boundaries, subject to a certain vote; 10 requiring the Authority to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor 11 and to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; 12 defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally 13 relating to the West North Avenue Development Authority.

It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of September 30, 2026, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
