CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – West North Avenue Development Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the West North Avenue Development Authority in
4 Baltimore City; providing for the composition, ~~chair, and staffing~~ and chair of the
5 Authority; authorizing the Authority to manage certain funds; prohibiting a member
6 of the Authority from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the
7 reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Authority to support and develop
8 a certain neighborhood revitalization plan in coordination with certain residents;
9 authorizing the Authority to modify certain boundaries, subject to a certain vote;
10 requiring the Authority to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor
11 and to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date;
12 defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally
13 relating to the West North Avenue Development Authority.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
8 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (B) “BUFFER ZONE” MEANS THE AREA WITHIN 250 YARDS OF THE TARGET
16 AREA.

17 (C) “TARGET AREA” MEANS THE PORTION OF WEST NORTH AVENUE IN
18 BALTIMORE CITY BETWEEN THE 600 BLOCK AND THE 3200 BLOCK, INCLUSIVE.

23 (A) THE AUTHORITY CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

24 (1) ONE MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND WHO REPRESENTS
25 THE TARGET AREA, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

26 (2) ONE MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES WHO REPRESENTS
27 THE TARGET AREA, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

28 (3) THE SECRETARY OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT,
29 OR THE SECRETARY’S DESIGNEE;

1 (4) THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION, OR THE SECRETARY'S
2 DESIGNEE;

3 (5) ONE MEMBER OF THE BALTIMORE CITY COUNCIL WHO
4 REPRESENTS THE TARGET AREA, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE
5 BALTIMORE CITY COUNCIL;

6 (6) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR OF BALTIMORE CITY;

7 (7) ONE MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

8 (8) THE DIRECTOR OF THE BALTIMORE DEVELOPMENT
9 CORPORATION, OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;

10 (9) THE COMMISSIONER OF THE BALTIMORE CITY DEPARTMENT OF
11 HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, OR THE COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNEE;

12 (10) THE DIRECTOR OF THE BALTIMORE CITY DEPARTMENT OF
13 TRANSPORTATION, OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;

14 (11) THE DIRECTOR OF THE BALTIMORE CITY DEPARTMENT OF
15 PLANNING, OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE;

16 (12) THE PRESIDENT OF COPPIN STATE UNIVERSITY, OR THE
17 PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE; ~~AND~~

18 (13) THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND INSTITUTE COLLEGE OF
19 ART, OR THE PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE; AND

20 (14) TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF COMMUNITIES IMPACTED
21 BY THE TARGET AREA OR BUFFER ZONE, SELECTED BY THE MAJORITY VOTE OF THE
22 LEADERSHIP OF THE FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS:

23 (I) ALLIANCE OF ROSEMONT COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS;

24 (II) BOLTON HILL COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION;

25 (III) COPPIN HEIGHTS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
26 CORPORATION;

27 (IV) DRUID HEIGHTS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
28 CORPORATION;

29 (V) GREATER MONDAWMIN COORDINATING COUNCIL;

1 (VI) PENN NORTH COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION; AND

2 (VII) COLLECTIVELY, THE LEADERSHIP OF THE RESERVOIR HILL
 3 IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL, THE RESERVOIR HILL ASSOCIATION, AND THE UPPER
 4 EUTAW MADISON NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION.

5 ~~(B) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS SHALL ELECT EITHER THE MEMBER~~
 6 ~~DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(12) OR (13) OF THIS SECTION TO BE THE CHAIR~~
 7 ~~OF THE AUTHORITY~~ THE PRESIDENT OF COPPIN STATE UNIVERSITY, OR THE
 8 PRESIDENT'S DESIGNEE, SHALL SERVE AS THE CHAIR OF THE AUTHORITY.

10 ~~(A) THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, IN COORDINATION WITH THE~~
 11 ~~AUTHORITY, SHALL PROVIDE STAFF FOR THE AUTHORITY. THE AUTHORITY MAY~~
 12 MANAGE APPROPRIATED FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF BALTIMORE AND THE STATE.

13 (B) THE AUTHORITY MAY RECEIVE DONATED SERVICES FROM
 14 ACCOUNTANTS, LAWYERS, OR OTHER CONSULTANTS AS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT
 15 THIS SUBTITLE.

16 (C) THE AUTHORITY MAY SUPERVISE, MANAGE, AND TERMINATE STAFF
 17 AND CONSULTANTS AS NECESSARY.

19 A MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY:

20 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE
 21 AUTHORITY; BUT

22 (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE
 23 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

25 (A) THE AUTHORITY SHALL:

26 (1) SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT AND APPROVAL OF A
 27 COMPREHENSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PLAN IN THE TARGET AREA
 28 AND THE BUFFER ZONE TO BENEFIT:

29 (I) THE RESIDENTS;

- 1 (II) HOUSING;
- 2 (III) NEIGHBORHOODS;
- 3 (IV) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND
- 4 (V) TRANSPORTATION, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND
- 5 PEDESTRIANS; AND

6 (2) WORK IN COORDINATION WITH THE RESIDENTS OF THE TARGET
 7 AREA AND THE BUFFER ZONE TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD
 8 REVITALIZATION PLAN.

9 (B) THE AUTHORITY MAY, BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS OF THE
 10 AUTHORITY, MODIFY THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TARGET AREA AND THE BUFFER
 11 ZONE.

12 (C) ON OR BEFORE ~~JULY 1, 2026~~ OCTOBER 1, 2023, THE AUTHORITY SHALL
 13 REPORT ITS COMPREHENSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION STRATEGY TO THE
 14 GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
 15 ARTICLE, TO THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE
 16 APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 18 October 1, 2021. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of September
 19 30, 2026, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be
 20 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
