1 AN ACT concerning

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- FOR the purpose of requiring the presidents of University System of Maryland institutions to ensure that a student committee is presented with any proposed fees for their review; requiring certain information to be provided to the student committee; requiring certain revenues to be retained by a certain campus unit or department unless the student committee approves the transfer of revenues to another campus unit or department; and generally relating to fees at University System of Maryland institutions.

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 26 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:



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Article - Education

- 3 (a) (1) Except as provided in Subtitle 3 of this title, and subject to paragraph
- 4 (2) of this subsection, in consultation with the Chancellor and after a thorough search, the
- 5 Board of Regents shall appoint a qualified person as president of each constituent
- 6 institution.
- 7 (2) The Board of Regents shall approve the membership of any search
- 8 committee convened to recommend a qualified person as president of a constituent
- 9 institution.
- 10 (e) Subject to the authority and applicable regulations and policies of the Board
- 11 of Regents, each president shall:
- 12 (7) [Set] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION, SET tuition
- 13 and fees;
- 14 (H) (1) (I) WHEN SETTING MANDATORY AND NONMANDATORY
- 15 STUDENT FEES, THE PRESIDENT OF EACH CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION SHALL
- 16 ENSURE THAT THE PROPOSED FEES ARE PRESENTED TO A COMMITTEE OF
- 17 STUDENTS FOR REVIEW.
- 18 (II) THE INFORMATION PROVIDED TO THE COMMITTEE SHALL
- 19 INCLUDE:
- 20 1. THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE;
- 21 2. THE STUDENTS WHO WILL BE CHARGED THE FEE; AND
- 22 3. The proposed use of the revenues generated
- 23 FROM THE FEE.
- 24 (III) AT LEAST QUARTERLY, THE PRESIDENT OF EACH
- 25 CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION SHALL ENSURE THAT THE COMMITTEE IS PROVIDED
- 26 WITH INFORMATION ON THE ACTUAL USE OF REVENUES GENERATED FROM THE FEE.
- 27 (2) THE REVENUES DERIVED FROM MANDATORY AND
- 28 NONMANDATORY FEES SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE CAMPUS UNIT OR DEPARTMENT
- 29 THAT IMPOSED THE FEE AND MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANY OTHER CAMPUS
- 30 UNIT OR DEPARTMENT FOR ANY REASON WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE
- 31 COMMITTEE OF STUDENTS THAT REVIEWED THE FEE.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July

1 1, 2021.
