16 17 18	(4) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have the same power with respect to the salaries of the Sheriff's Office as they have under the city charter with respect to the salaries of all municipal departments.
19 20	(5) Employees of the Sheriff's Office, except the Sheriff, shall be selected according to the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
$21 \\ 22 \\ 23$	(f) (1) The Mayor and City Council shall pay monthly to the Sheriff one twelfth of the amount provided in the ordinance of estimates for the expenses of the Sheriff's Office.
24 25 26 27	(2) Within 30 days after June 30th in each and every year the Sheriff shall pay to the Mayor and City Council any of the unexpended expense funds advanced during the preceding year and render a detailed account to the Mayor and City Council of all expense funds received and expended by the Sheriff.
28 29 30	(3) The Mayor and City Council shall reimburse the State for the administrative costs incurred because the employees of the Sheriff's Office are in the State Personnel Management System.
31 32 33	(g) During the course of a deputy sheriff's employment, any deputy sheriff of the city may ride in the city on public transportation of the Maryland Transit Administration without paying any fare if the deputy sheriff shows proper identification regarding

34 employment as a deputy sheriff.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2021.
