1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Economic Development – Partnership for Workforce Quality Program –**  
3 **Alterations**

4 FOR the purpose of expanding the purpose of the Partnership for Workforce Quality  
5 Program and the eligible uses of the grant under the Program to include training for  
6 new employees; and generally relating to the Partnership for Workforce Quality  
7 Program.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
9 Article – Economic Development  
10 Section 3–401 and 3–402

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Economic Development**

2 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

3 (b) “Board” means the Partnership for Workforce Quality Advisory Board.

4 (c) “Fund” means the Partnership for Workforce Quality Fund.

5 (d) “Program” means the Partnership for Workforce Quality Program.

6 3-402.

7 There is a Partnership for Workforce Quality Program in the Department.

8 3-403.

9 The purpose of the Program is to provide training services to:

10 (1) improve the competitiveness and productivity of the State’s workforce  
11 and business community;

12 (2) upgrade employee skills, **OR TRAIN NEW EMPLOYEES**, for new  
13 technologies or production processes; and

14 (3) assist employers located in the State in promoting employment  
15 stability.

16 3-405.

17 (a) (1) An employer receiving assistance under the Program shall be located in  
18 the State.

19 (2) In order to receive assistance under the Program, an employer shall  
20 request training assistance in job-specific skills to **TRAIN NEW EMPLOYEES OR TO**  
21 upgrade or retain existing Maryland-based employees covered under Title 8 of the Labor  
22 and Employment Article.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
24 1, 2021.
