Resolution to End the State of Emergency

FOR the purpose of terminating the Governor's state of emergency and declaring the intent of the General Assembly to order the Governor to cease issuing renewals of the state of emergency.

6 WHEREAS, Since March 5, 2020, Maryland has been placed under a declared state 7 of emergency by the Governor for a pandemic for which science demonstrates, as stated by 8 the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on September 10, 2020, there is a 9 99.98% average chance of survival for individuals age 0–19, a 99.8% chance of survival for 10 individuals age 20–49, a 99.5% chance of survival for individuals age 50–69, and a 94.6% 11 chance of survival for individuals age 70 and older; and

WHEREAS, More people have died or been harmed by the state of emergency than by the pandemic, including through the unlawful closure of churches, businesses, and schools, causing a growing crisis in mental health, overdoses, and suicide, according to the CDC's reports dated August 14, 2020, and October 8, 2020; and

16 WHEREAS, Under § 14–107 of the Public Safety Article, a declaration of a state of 17 emergency may last only 30 days unless renewed by the Governor, and the General 18 Assembly never intended to authorize the Governor to continually renew a state of 19 emergency declaration in the manner that the Governor has this year; and

WHEREAS, To protect the lives and livelihoods of Maryland citizens, the state of emergency must be terminated; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That, in accordance with § 14–107 of the Public Safety Article, the Governor's state of emergency which began on March 5, 2020, and has continued through many and varied orders to this date, is hereby terminated; and be it further
