A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Integrity Act**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain agent of a voter to be a family member or member
4 of the voter's household to pick up and deliver the voter's absentee ballot; prohibiting
5 a certain campaign volunteer from being designated by a voter as a certain agent to
6 pick up and deliver an absentee ballot; prohibiting a certain agent of a voter from
7 picking up and delivering more than a certain number of absentee ballots during
8 each election; and generally relating to the use of an agent to pick up and deliver
9 absentee ballots.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 (a) A qualified applicant may designate a duly authorized agent to pick up and

1 deliver an absentee ballot under this subtitle.

2 (b) An agent of the voter under this section:

3 (1) must be at least 18 years old;

4 **(2) MUST BE A FAMILY MEMBER OR MEMBER OF THE HOUSEHOLD OF**
5 **THE VOTER;**

6 **[(2)] (3)** may not be a **CAMPAIGN VOLUNTEER OF A CANDIDATE ON**
7 **THAT BALLOT OR A** candidate on that ballot;

8 **(4) MAY NOT PICK UP OR DELIVER MORE THAN THREE BALLOTS**
9 **DURING EACH ELECTION;**

10 **[(3)] (5)** shall be designated in a writing signed by the voter under penalty
11 of perjury; and

12 **[(4)] (6)** shall execute an affidavit under penalty of perjury that the ballot
13 was:

14 (i) delivered to the voter who submitted the application;

15 (ii) marked and placed in an envelope by the voter, or with
16 assistance as allowed by regulation, in the agent's presence; and

17 (iii) returned to the local board by the agent.

19 Any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this subtitle is
20 subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment for not more than 2 years or both.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2021.
