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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Police Officers – Mental Health – Employee Assistance Programs**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring each law enforcement agency to develop and implement a  
4 certain program to protect the mental health of police officers; establishing certain  
5 requirements for a certain program; requiring each law enforcement agency to  
6 develop a policy to minimize certain costs to police officers; defining certain terms;  
7 and generally relating to the mental health of police officers.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Public Safety**

16 **3–523.**

17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS  
18 INDICATED.

19 (2) “EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM” MEANS A WORK-BASED  
20 PROGRAM OFFERED TO ALL POLICE OFFICERS THAT PROVIDES ACCESS TO  
21 VOLUNTARY AND CONFIDENTIAL SERVICES TO ADDRESS THE MENTAL HEALTH  
22 ISSUES OF A POLICE OFFICER STEMMING FROM PERSONAL AND WORK-RELATED  
23 CONCERNS, INCLUDING STRESS, FINANCIAL ISSUES, LEGAL ISSUES, FAMILY

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 PROBLEMS, OFFICE CONFLICTS, AND ALCOHOL AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISORDERS.

2 (3) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §  
3 3-201 OF THIS TITLE.

4 (4) "POLICE OFFICER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 3-201 OF THIS  
5 TITLE.

6 (B) EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS TO AN  
7 EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM OR A MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM FOR ALL  
8 POLICE OFFICERS THAT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY EMPLOYS.

9 (C) THE EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION  
10 SHALL PROVIDE POLICE OFFICERS ACCESS TO CONFIDENTIAL MENTAL HEALTH  
11 SERVICES, INCLUDING:

12 (1) COUNSELING SERVICES;

13 (2) CRISIS COUNSELING;

14 (3) STRESS MANAGEMENT COUNSELING;

15 (4) MENTAL HEALTH EVALUATIONS; AND

16 (5) PEER SUPPORT SERVICES FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

17 (D) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 3-516 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AS  
18 PART OF THE EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION, EACH  
19 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL PROVIDE TO ALL POLICE OFFICERS THE  
20 AGENCY EMPLOYS A VOLUNTARY MENTAL HEALTH CONSULTATION OR COUNSELING  
21 SERVICES BEFORE THE POLICE OFFICER RETURNS TO FULL DUTY FOLLOWING ANY  
22 INCIDENT INVOLVING:

23 (1) A SERIOUS INJURY TO THE POLICE OFFICER;

24 (2) AN OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING;

25 (3) AN ACCIDENT RESULTING IN A FATALITY; OR

26 (4) ANY USE OF FORCE RESULTING IN A FATALITY OR SERIOUS  
27 INJURY.

28 (E) THE EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION  
29 SHALL INCLUDE A COMPONENT DESIGNED TO PROTECT THE MENTAL HEALTH OF

1 POLICE OFFICERS DURING PERIODS OF PUBLIC DEMONSTRATIONS AND UNREST.

2 (F) EACH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL DEVELOP A POLICY TO  
3 PROVIDE ACCESS TO THE SERVICES REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION AT MINIMAL COST  
4 TO A POLICE OFFICER.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 2021.
