BY adding to Article - State Government Section 9–3301 through 9–3304 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 33. Governor's Office of Immigrant Affairs" Annotated Code of Maryland (2014 Replacement Volume and 2020 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Government SUBTITLE 33. GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS.
