A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Public High Schools – Health Education – Gambling Dangers and Addiction

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, on or before a certain 4 date, to develop a certain program of education on the dangers of gambling and $\mathbf{5}$ gambling addiction; requiring the program to be coordinated with other State 6 agencies responsible for gambling addiction education and control; authorizing a 7 county board of education, beginning in a certain school year, to require each public 8 high school in the county to include instruction on gambling dangers and addiction 9 once during a certain period of time; authorizing the State Board of Education to 10 adopt regulations to implement this Act; requiring the Department, on or before a 11 certain date, to report to the Governor and the General Assembly on the county 12boards that required instruction on the dangers of gambling and gambling addiction, 13including information on the program of education that each county board used; and 14 generally relating to education on the dangers of gambling and gambling addiction 15for students in public high schools.

1 (A) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2022, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A 2 PROGRAM OF EDUCATION ON THE DANGERS OF GAMBLING AND GAMBLING 3 ADDICTION TO BE PROVIDED IN PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS.

4 (B) THE GAMBLING DANGERS AND ADDICTION EDUCATION PROGRAM 5 SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH OTHER STATE AGENCIES THAT ARE RESPONSIBLE 6 FOR GAMBLING ADDICTION EDUCATION AND CONTROL, INCLUDING THE 7 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION OF THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF 8 HEALTH.

9 (C) BEGINNING IN THE 2022–2023 SCHOOL YEAR, A COUNTY BOARD MAY 10 REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY TO INCLUDE INSTRUCTION ON 11 THE DANGERS OF GAMBLING AND GAMBLING ADDICTION ONE TIME FOR STUDENTS 12 DURING GRADES 9 THROUGH 12.

13(D) THE STATE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE14REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

15 (E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2024, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT 16 TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE 17 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE COUNTY BOARDS THAT 18 REQUIRED INSTRUCTION ON THE DANGERS OF GAMBLING AND GAMBLING 19 ADDICTION, INCLUDING INFORMATION ON THE PROGRAM OF EDUCATION THAT 20 EACH COUNTY BOARD USED.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2021.
