## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Education - Voluntary Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education to establish the Voluntary 4 Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate Program on or before a certain date; 5 specifying the purpose of the Program; specifying certain qualifications and 6 application procedures for a certain certificate; requiring the Department to issue a 7 certificate to any applicant who meets certain requirements; authorizing an 8 applicant to petition for judicial review of a decision of the Department that relates 9 to issuing or renewing a certificate; providing that a certificate authorizes an 10 individual to represent to the public that the individual is a certified ethical special 11 education advocate while the certificate is effective; providing for the renewal of a 12 certificate; requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain term; providing for the construction of this Act; and generally relating to the 13 Voluntary Ethical Special Education Advocate Certificate Program. 14

- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 22 Article Education
- 23 **8–420.**
- 24 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE VOLUNTARY ETHICAL

- 1 SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- 2 (B) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2022, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A 3 VOLUNTARY ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM.
- 4 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO
- 5 ADMINISTER A VOLUNTARY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM FOR ETHICAL SPECIAL
- 6 EDUCATION ADVOCATES.
- 7 (D) TO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:
- 8 (1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT ON THE FORM
- 9 THAT THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES; AND
- 10 (2) PAY TO THE DEPARTMENT THE APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE
- 11 **DEPARTMENT.**
- 12 (E) TO QUALIFY FOR A CERTIFICATE AS AN ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION
- 13 ADVOCATE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE FOLLOWING
- 14 **REQUIREMENTS:**
- 15 (1) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER;
- 16 (2) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD; AND
- 17 (3) THE APPLICANT SHALL, AT A MINIMUM:
- 18 (I) HAVE COMPLETED AN ONLINE TRAINING MODULE OR
- 19 WEBINAR APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND
- 20 (II) PASS AN ONLINE EXAMINATION APPROVED BY THE STATE
- 21 BOARD ON THE ONLINE TRAINING MODULE OR WEBINAR.
- 22 (F) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO ANY APPLICANT
- 23 WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 24 (G) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH CERTIFICATE THAT THE
- 25 STATE BOARD ISSUES:
- 26 (1) THE FULL NAME OF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER; AND
- 27 (2) A SERIAL NUMBER.

- 1 (H) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A CERTIFICATE TO REPLACE A LOST, 2 DESTROYED, OR MUTILATED CERTIFICATE IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER PAYS THE 3 CERTIFICATE REPLACEMENT FEE SET BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 4 (I) AN APPLICANT TO WHOM THE DEPARTMENT HAS ISSUED A
  5 CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL MAINTAIN ON FILE WITH THE
  6 DEPARTMENT THE APPLICANT'S CURRENT RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS AND BUSINESS
  7 ADDRESS AND UPDATE THE INFORMATION WHENEVER CHANGES IN RESIDENCY OR
  8 EMPLOYMENT OCCUR.
- 9 (J) THE APPLICANT MAY PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A DECISION 10 OF THE DEPARTMENT THAT RELATES TO ISSUING OR RENEWING A CERTIFICATE AS 11 ALLOWED BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT.
- 12 **(K)** A CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZES AN INDIVIDUAL TO REPRESENT TO THE 13 PUBLIC THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS A CERTIFIED ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE WHILE THE CERTIFICATE IS EFFECTIVE.
- 15 (L) (1) A CERTIFICATE EXPIRES ON A DATE SET BY THE DEPARTMENT, 16 UNLESS THE CERTIFICATE IS RENEWED FOR AN ADDITIONAL TERM AS PROVIDED IN 17 THIS SECTION.
- 18 (2) A CERTIFICATE MAY NOT BE RENEWED FOR A TERM LONGER THAN 19 2 YEARS.
- 20 (M) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE
  21 DEPARTMENT SHALL SEND TO THE CERTIFIED ETHICAL SPECIAL EDUCATION
  22 ADVOCATE, BY ELECTRONIC MEANS OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN
  23 ELECTRONIC OR PHYSICAL ADDRESS OF THE ADVOCATE, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT
  24 STATES:
- 25 (1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT CERTIFICATE EXPIRES;
- 26 (2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES; AND
- 29 (3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
- 30 (N) BEFORE THE CERTIFICATE EXPIRES, THE SPECIAL EDUCATION 31 ADVOCATE MAY RENEW THE CERTIFICATE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM IF THE 32 SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE:

- 1 (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE;
- 2 (2) PAYS TO THE DEPARTMENT THE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE 3 DEPARTMENT; AND
- 4 (3) SUBMITS TO THE DEPARTMENT:
- 5 (I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE 6 DEPARTMENT REQUIRES; AND
- 7 (II) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY 8 QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR CERTIFICATE 9 RENEWAL.
- 10 (O) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL RENEW THE CERTIFICATE OF EACH SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVOCATE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 12 (P) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE 13 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 14 (Q) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT OR PREVENT A
  15 PARENT OR GUARDIAN FROM CHOOSING A NONCERTIFIED ADVOCATE OR ANY
  16 OTHER ADVOCATE TO ADVOCATE ON THEIR BEHALF IN ANY PROCEEDING OR
  17 PROCESS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEDERAL INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES
  18 EDUCATION ACT.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 20 1, 2021.
