## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Vehicle Laws – Injury or Death of Vulnerable Individual – Penalties

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an individual from causing the serious physical injury or 4 death of a vulnerable individual as a result of the individual operating a vehicle in 5 violation of certain provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law; establishing certain 6 penalties for a violation of this Act; establishing that an individual charged with a 7 violation of this Act must appear in court and may not prepay the fine; requiring the 8 Motor Vehicle Administration to suspend for a certain amount of time the driver's 9 license of an individual convicted of a violation of this Act; defining the term 10 "vulnerable individual" for purposes of this Act; and generally relating to penalties 11 for causing the serious physical injury or death of a vulnerable individual.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
