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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Natural Resources – Fishing and Hunting Rights**

3 FOR the purpose of stating certain findings of the General Assembly related to fishing and  
4 hunting; establishing that it is the intent of the General Assembly that residents of  
5 the State have a right to fish and to hunt subject to certain regulations and  
6 restrictions; and generally relating to the right to fish and hunt.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Natural Resources**

2 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT:

3 (1) FISHING IS A VALUED PART OF THE STATE'S CULTURAL AND  
4 SOCIAL HERITAGE THAT PROVIDES UNIQUE RECREATIONAL BENEFITS TO  
5 RESIDENTS OF THE STATE; AND

6 (2) FISHING PLAYS AN IMPORTANT PART IN THE STATE'S ECONOMY  
7 BY CONTRIBUTING TO TAX REVENUES AND EMPLOYMENT AND SUPPORTS THE  
8 CONSERVATION, PRESERVATION, AND MANAGEMENT OF THE STATE'S FISHERIES,  
9 NATURAL AREAS, AND WATER RESOURCES.

10 (B) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT RESIDENTS OF THE  
11 STATE HAVE A RIGHT TO FISH SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS  
12 UNDER LAWS THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENACTS.

14 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT:

15 (1) HUNTING IS A VALUED PART OF THE STATE'S CULTURAL AND  
16 SOCIAL HERITAGE THAT PROVIDES UNIQUE RECREATIONAL BENEFITS TO  
17 RESIDENTS OF THE STATE; AND

18 (2) HUNTING PLAYS AN IMPORTANT PART IN THE STATE'S ECONOMY  
19 BY CONTRIBUTING TO TAX REVENUES AND EMPLOYMENT AND, THROUGH THE  
20 RECEIPT OF FEDERAL FUNDS, SUPPORTS THE CONSERVATION, PRESERVATION, AND  
21 MANAGEMENT OF THE STATE'S WILDLIFE, NATURAL AREAS, AND RELATED  
22 RESOURCES.

23 (B) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT RESIDENTS OF THE  
24 STATE HAVE A RIGHT TO HUNT SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS  
25 UNDER LAWS THAT THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENACTS.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
27 October 1, 2021.
