- 17 (a) A parent may not willfully fail to provide for the support of his or her minor 18 child.
- 19 (b) A parent may not desert his or her minor child.
- 20 (c) An individual who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$100 or imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or both.
