# Public Institutions of Higher Education – Incarcerated and Formerly Incarcerated Individuals – Academic and Employment Opportunities

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission, in consultation
with public institutions of higher education and Maryland Correctional Enterprises,
to establish a certain process to increase access to certain academic and employment
opportunities at public institutions of higher education for certain incarcerated and
formerly incarcerated individuals; specifying certain requirements for the process;
and generally relating to public institutions of higher education and opportunities
for incarcerated and formerly incarcerated individuals.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **Article – Education**

20 (A) THE COMMISSION, IN CONSULTATION WITH PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF 21 HIGHER EDUCATION AND MARYLAND CORRECTIONAL ENTERPRISES, SHALL 22 ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO PROVIDE INFORMATION AND OUTREACH TO 23 INCARCERATED AND FORMERLY INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS TO INCREASE THE 24 INDIVIDUALS' ACCESS TO ADMISSIONS AND EMPLOYMENT AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS 25 OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

1 (B) THE PROCESS ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 2 SHALL:

3 (1) APPLY ONLY TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE OR WERE EMPLOYED BY
 4 MARYLAND CORRECTIONAL ENTERPRISES DURING THE INDIVIDUAL'S PERIOD OF
 5 INCARCERATION;

6 (2) PROVIDE INFORMATION AND OUTREACH TO FORMERLY
7 INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS REGARDING OPPORTUNITIES TO PURSUE HIGHER
8 EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION;
9 AND

10 (3) PROVIDE INFORMATION AND OUTREACH TO INCARCERATED 11 INDIVIDUALS REGARDING OPPORTUNITIES TO PURSUE HIGHER EDUCATION AND 12 EMPLOYMENT AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION AFTER RELEASE 13 FROM INCARCERATION.

14 (C) THE PROCESS ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 15 SHALL INCLUDE:

16 (1) TO THE EXTENT FEASIBLE, GRANTING PREFERENCE TO 17 FORMERLY INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS IN ADMISSIONS AND EMPLOYMENT 18 APPLICATIONS;

19(2) PROVIDING GUIDANCE TO FORMERLY INCARCERATED20INDIVIDUALS THROUGHOUT THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR ADMISSION OR21EMPLOYMENT; AND

22 (3) PROVIDING INFORMATION REGARDING THE MARYLAND 23 TRANSFER ADVANTAGE PROGRAM TO INCARCERATED AND FORMERLY 24 INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2021.
