BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Transportation Section 21–10A–02 Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
