## State Board of Social Work Examiners – Revisions

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain individuals employed by federal agencies to comply 4 with certain provisions of law; establishing a certain date by which an applicant to  $\mathbf{5}$ obtain a certified social worker license is required to meet certain requirements; 6 altering the number of hours of certain supervision an applicant for a certified social 7 worker-clinical license is required to complete; specifying that certain supervision is 8 to be provided in accordance with regulations adopted by the State Board of Social Work Examiners; requiring that certain electronic license records include 9 disciplinary history if applicable; prohibiting a licensed certified social worker from 10 11 engaging in private practice; repealing the requirement for the Board to issue a 12certain renewal certificate; replacing the "social worker rehabilitation committee" 13 with the "social worker rehabilitation process" and altering certain requirements; 14repealing references to the obsolete license category licensed graduate social worker; 15increasing a certain fine for a certain violation; altering the short title of certain 16 provisions of law: altering certain definitions; repealing certain obsolete provisions 17of law; updating certain terminology; making stylistic changes; and generally 18 relating to the State Board of Social Work Examiners.
