## Correctional Officers' Retirement System – Kent County

3 FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System for certain local detention center officers of Kent County under certain 4  $\mathbf{5}$ circumstances; providing that a certain individual is entitled to eligibility service and 6 creditable service that was earned before the effective date of Kent County's 7 participation in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System; providing that an 8 individual who receives certain service credit is not a member of and has no rights 9 to a benefit in the Employees' Pension System; providing for the transfer of creditable service for a certain individual; providing for the transfer and crediting of certain 1011 assets on the effective date of participation; and generally relating to Kent County's 12participation in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
  - Article State Personnel and Pensions

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(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A LOCAL DETENTION
 CENTER OFFICER OF KENT COUNTY BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO
 REMAINS A LOCAL DETENTION CENTER OFFICER OF KENT COUNTY THROUGH THE
 EFFECTIVE DATE.

1lr0942 CF HB 456 1 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IF KENT COUNTY 2 BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE CORRECTIONAL 3 OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, MEMBERSHIP IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' 4 RETIREMENT SYSTEM IS MANDATORY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER 5 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

6 (C) IF KENT COUNTY COMMENCES PARTICIPATION IN THE CORRECTIONAL 7 OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS 8 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS 9 ENTITLED TO ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AND CREDITABLE SERVICE IN THE 10 CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH KENT 11 COUNTY BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 (D) ON JOINING THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM 13 AND RECEIVING SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 14 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 15 SHALL:

16 (1) NO LONGER BE A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION 17 SYSTEM; AND

18 (2) HAVE NO FURTHER RIGHTS TO ANY BENEFIT IN THE EMPLOYEES'
 19 PENSION SYSTEM.

20 (E) THE TRANSFER OF CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL 21 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE 22 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO 23 TRANSFERS TO THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER THIS 24 SECTION, IS NOT GOVERNED BY TITLE 37 OF THIS ARTICLE.

25 (F) IF KENT COUNTY BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN 26 THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, § 31–2B–05(C) OF THIS 27 SUBTITLE SHALL GOVERN THE TRANSFER AND CREDITING OF ASSETS ON THE 28 EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
 1, 2021.
