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Correctional Officers' Retirement System – Kent County

3 FOR the purpose of requiring membership in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System for certain local detention center officers of Kent County under certain 4 $\mathbf{5}$ circumstances; providing that a certain individual is entitled to eligibility service and 6 creditable service that was earned before the effective date of Kent County's 7 participation in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System; providing that an 8 individual who receives certain service credit is not a member of and has no rights 9 to a benefit in the Employees' Pension System; providing for the transfer of creditable 10 service for a certain individual; providing for the transfer and crediting of certain 11 assets on the effective date of participation; and generally relating to Kent County's 12 participation in the Correctional Officers' Retirement System.

1 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A LOCAL DETENTION 2 CENTER OFFICER OF KENT COUNTY BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO 3 REMAINS A LOCAL DETENTION CENTER OFFICER OF KENT COUNTY THROUGH THE 4 EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, IF KENT COUNTY 6 BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE CORRECTIONAL 7 OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, MEMBERSHIP IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' 8 RETIREMENT SYSTEM IS MANDATORY FOR AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER 9 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

10 (C) IF KENT COUNTY COMMENCES PARTICIPATION IN THE CORRECTIONAL 11 OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS 12 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS 13 ENTITLED TO ELIGIBILITY SERVICE AND CREDITABLE SERVICE IN THE 14 CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH KENT 15 COUNTY BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 (D) ON JOINING THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM 17 AND RECEIVING SERVICE CREDIT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS 18 SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION 19 SHALL:

20 (1) NO LONGER BE A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION 21 SYSTEM; AND

22 (2) HAVE NO FURTHER RIGHTS TO ANY BENEFIT IN THE EMPLOYEES' 23 PENSION SYSTEM.

24 (E) THE TRANSFER OF CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL 25 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE 26 EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM THROUGH THE EFFECTIVE DATE, AND WHO 27 TRANSFERS TO THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER THIS 28 SECTION, IS NOT GOVERNED BY TITLE **37** OF THIS ARTICLE.

(F) IF KENT COUNTY BECOMES A PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTAL UNIT IN THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, § 31–2B–05(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL GOVERN THE TRANSFER AND CREDITING OF ASSETS ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE.
