11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Agriculture**

14 8–301.

15 **(A)** The 24 soil conservation districts are established and continued with
16 boundaries corresponding to county boundaries, except for Frederick County, and include
17 all land and water and incorporated areas, as follows:

18 (1) Allegany Soil Conservation District;

3 **(B) A BALTIMORE CITY SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT MAY BE**
4 **ESTABLISHED AND CONTINUED WITH BOUNDARIES CORRESPONDING TO THE**
5 **BOUNDARIES OF BALTIMORE CITY.**

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2021.
