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

5 6 7	WHEREAS, David Perez was a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, and a veteran of the U.S. Army who served in Iraq from 2005 to 2006, whose passion in life was helping others; and
8 9 10	WHEREAS, Mr. Perez was known for his enthusiasm, drive, and energy in helping people in his community, including veterans living with post—traumatic stress disorder and other mental illnesses, to create more support systems and assistance; and
11 12 13	WHEREAS, Mr. Perez's life was taken far too soon and he deserves to be honored for his compassion and commitment to the service of others, especially fellow veterans; now, therefore,
14 15	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18	(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
19	(b) "Board" means the Board of Trustees of the Maryland Veterans Trust.
20	(c) "Fund" means the Maryland Veterans Trust Fund.
21	(d) "Trust" means the Maryland Veterans Trust.
22 23	(e) (1) There is a Maryland Veterans Trust established for the purpose of providing monetary and other assistance to:
24	(i) veterans and their families; and
25 26	(ii) public and private programs that support veterans and their families.
27	(2) There is a Maryland Veterans Trust Fund.
28 29 30	(f) The Trust shall be a body corporate and shall have perpetual existence, subject to modification or termination by the General Assembly if necessary to effectuate its purpose or if its substantial purpose ceases to exist.

12	(2) ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS.
