CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – West North Avenue Development Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the West North Avenue Development Authority in
4 Baltimore City; authorizing the Authority to manage certain funds; providing for the
5 composition, ~~chair, and staffing~~ and chair of the Authority; prohibiting a member of
6 the Authority from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the
7 reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Authority to support and develop
8 a certain neighborhood revitalization plan in coordination with certain residents;
9 authorizing the Authority to modify certain boundaries, subject to a certain vote;
10 requiring the Authority to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor
11 and to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date;
12 defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally
13 relating to the West North Avenue Development Authority.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Economic Development**

27 A MEMBER OF THE AUTHORITY:

28 (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE
29 AUTHORITY; BUT

1 **(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE**
2 **STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.**

4 **(A) THE AUTHORITY SHALL:**

5 **(1) SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT AND APPROVAL OF A**
6 **COMPREHENSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PLAN IN THE TARGET AREA**
7 **AND THE BUFFER ZONE TO BENEFIT:**

8 **(I) THE RESIDENTS;**

9 **(II) HOUSING;**

10 **(III) NEIGHBORHOODS;**

11 **(IV) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; AND**

12 **(V) TRANSPORTATION, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND**
13 **PEDESTRIANS; AND**

14 **(2) WORK IN COORDINATION WITH THE RESIDENTS OF THE TARGET**
15 **AREA AND THE BUFFER ZONE TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD**
16 **REVITALIZATION PLAN.**

17 **(B) THE AUTHORITY MAY, BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF ALL MEMBERS OF THE**
18 **AUTHORITY, MODIFY THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TARGET AREA AND THE BUFFER**
19 **ZONE.**

20 **(C) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2023, THE AUTHORITY SHALL REPORT ITS**
21 **COMPREHENSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION STRATEGY TO THE GOVERNOR**
22 **AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO**
23 **THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE**
24 **APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE.**

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2021. It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of September
27 30, 2026, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be
28 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
