A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Health Occupations – Licensed Dentists – Administration of Vaccines

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a licensed dentist to administer certain vaccines to certain 4 individuals under certain circumstances; authorizing the State Board of Dental $\mathbf{5}$ Examiners to adopt certain regulations regarding the administration of vaccines; 6 requiring a licensed dentist who administers a vaccine to administer the vaccine 7 under a certain protocol and report the vaccination to the ImmuNet Program; 8 requiring a licensed dentist who administers a vaccine in accordance with a 9 prescription to make certain attempts to communicate certain information to the 10authorized prescriber; requiring a licensed dentist who administers a certain vaccine 11 to make certain attempts to communicate certain information to the patient's 12primary care provider in certain circumstances; requiring a licensed dentist to obtain 13 certain information and consent from a patient or patient's representative before 14administering a vaccine; requiring a licensed dentist who administers a vaccine to 15enter certain information in the patient's chart and provide the patient or the 16patient's representative with an immunization card and a certain document 17following the administration of a vaccine except under certain circumstances; 18 requiring a licensed dentist who administers a vaccine to record certain information 19in the patient's chart in certain circumstances; requiring a licensed dentist to 20complete a certain course, file a certain certificate, and receive a certain 21acknowledgment before administering certain vaccines; providing that a certain 22course may be completed in a certain undergraduate program under certain 23circumstances; establishing certain continuing education requirements for licensed 24dentists who administer certain vaccines; authorizing a licensed dentist to 25administer certain vaccines in the event that a certain individual declares a certain 26emergency; suspending certain requirements of this Act for the duration of a certain 27emergency; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to licensed dentists 28and the administration of vaccines.

(XIII) THE NAME OF THE URGENT CARE CENTER AND HOSPITAL
CLOSEST TO THE SITE AT WHICH THE VACCINE WAS ADMINISTERED.

1 (D) (1) BEFORE A LICENSED DENTIST MAY ADMINISTER A VACCINE 2 UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, A LICENSED DENTIST MUST:

3 (I) SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE A BOARD-APPROVED COURSE 4 THAT INCLUDES INSTRUCTION IN THE GUIDELINES AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF 5 THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION REGARDING VACCINES;

6 (II) FILE THE COURSE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION WITH THE 7 BOARD; AND

8 (III) RECEIVE AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF COURSE COMPLETION 9 FROM THE BOARD.

10 (2) THE BOARD-APPROVED COURSE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH 11 (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, BE COMPLETED 12 IN AN UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM AT A BOARD-APPROVED SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY 13 IF THE CURRICULUM INCLUDES INSTRUCTION IN THE GUIDELINES AND 14 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION 15 REGARDING VACCINES.

16 (3) IN ORDER TO REMAIN ELIGIBLE TO ADMINISTER VACCINES AFTER 17 COMPLETING THE REQUIREMENTS IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A 18 LICENSED DENTIST SHALL:

19(I)COMPLETE A BOARD-APPROVED CONTINUING EDUCATION20CLASS OF AT LEAST 2 HOURS EVERY OTHER RENEWAL CYCLE THAT ADDRESSES:

211.THE PROPER PRESCRIBING AND DISPOSAL OF22PRESCRIPTION DRUGS; AND

232.ADVERSE INTERACTIONS AND ACTIONS OF VACCINES;24AND

25(II) MAINTAINCARDIOPULMONARYRESUSCITATION26CERTIFICATION AS REQUIRED BY THE BOARD.

(E) (1) IN THE EVENT THAT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OR THE GOVERNOR DECLARES A HEALTH-RELATED EMERGENCY RELATED TO AN ILLNESS FOR WHICH THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION HAS APPROVED A VACCINE, A LICENSED DENTIST MAY ADMINISTER ANY VACCINE THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION TO PREVENT THE ILLNESS FOR WHICH THE EMERGENCY WAS DECLARED.

1 (2) FOR THE DURATION OF THE EMERGENCY, THE EDUCATIONAL 2 REQUIREMENTS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION ARE SUSPENDED.

3 (F) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2021.
