A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

States of Emergency and Catastrophic Health Emergencies – Renewals – Authorization by Legislative Policy Committee

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Governor from renewing a state of emergency or
catastrophic health emergency for more than a certain period of time without
approval from a majority of the Legislative Policy Committee; authorizing the
Committee to vote on certain requests at a meeting held either in person or virtually;
clarifying that a state of emergency expires under certain circumstances; and
generally relating to the renewal of states of emergency and catastrophic health
emergencies.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Public Safety

20 (a) (1) If the Governor finds that an emergency has developed or is impending 21 due to any cause, the Governor shall declare a state of emergency by executive order or 22 proclamation.

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(2) The state of emergency continues until [the Governor]:
