<p>The Bowie Lions has been serving the Bowie community since 1962. In 1966 the Lions purchased the telephone building in the Huntington section of Bowie. The building serves as a meeting place for the Bowie Lions and community activities for the past 55 years. The city of Bowie has used the building for city-run programs. Churches use the building for religious services and church related functions. Local businesses use it for meetings and training sessions. the Community uses it for social functions from birthday and anniversary parties to wedding receptions. The building is part of the city's disaster emergency program. It would be used as a distribution center for food, water, and other items as needed. It could also be used as a cooling/ heating center.</p>
