The area for the amphitheater is next to the building, adjacent to the parking lot. The parking lot is currently undergoing a renovation with a matching grant from Maryland Heritage Areas Authority of \$40,000. We expect this to be complete before July 1, 2021. The same project manager will manage the amphitheater project.

We are also anticipating other improvements to the park with a grant the City of Annapolis is anticipating to make improvements in the City's green spaces. This will add interest for local residents to visit the park and add to participation in outdoor programs held in the amphitheater.
