Since 2001 in Baltimore, HOA has led 152 projects, impacted over 43,377 students, engaged 4,061 volunteers & distributed 158,841 books.

The scope of this project is to enhance Covid-19 prevention and other security measures at Curtis Bay Elementary School in Baltimore, MD, through a physical space reconfiguration of their administrative offices. The current floor plan is not ideal in terms of being able to control who enters the building and classroom areas because the current office/administrative spaces do not serve as an entry point for the facility because they are located behind the hallways leading to those areas. By relocating the current office/administration space forward from the rear of the front entry area, we could reinforce Covid-19 safety measures and overall security for the entire facility.
