10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

The City of Hyattsville is one of 27 incorporated municipalities within Prince George's County, Maryland. It was established in 1886 and adopted its present Charter in 1983 and currently has a population of approximately 18,000 people. Located just minutes from Washington D. C., 28 miles from downtown Baltimore and 24 miles west of Annapolis, the City is easily accessible by two metro rail stations within three commercial corridors. The executive offices of the City are located at the Municipal Building, 4310 Gallatin Street. City operations include the Police Department, Department of Public Works, Community Services and Community Development all of which provide services to its residents and ensures that the community is publicly safe and structurally sound.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The City of Hyattsville recently purchased a small commercial facility at 5812 40th Ave to be the home of the new Teen Center. The project is to renovate the existing structure into a multi use open space facility. They design will allow for the hosting of one large event, or several smaller events by using furniture to redefine the spaces as needed on the inside. On the outside the plan is to expand the existing Nicholson St pocket park by approximate 150% and create a series of outdoor spaces/rooms with each space being designed to host different social and physical activities. The centerpiece will be a large "front porch" that will be welcoming and serve as a focal point and help blend into the community.
