10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

Islamic Center of Maryland (ICM) was established in 1991 as a community center and is a non-profit serving Maryland residents. The center provide services to all the residents irrespective of faith, ethnicity, race, national origin or any factor. Since the start of the pandemic, the center has also become a focal point to provide food support for hundreds of area residents. ICM has partnered with MANNA and other organizations to distribute food to the residents and has distributed over 500,000 pounds of food to thousands of area residents. The center also provided financial assistance to the area residents by helping with food, rent, utility bills with over \$300k of donations from it's members in the year 2020 alone. The center also provides opportunity for the youth to volunteer by assisting in food packing, distribution and are rewarded with SSL hours.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

This project consists of a new 45,000 sq ft facility. It houses a fully equipped and FREE medical clinic for less privileged and is open to all residents regardless of religion, race, ethnicity and national origin. It also consists of a senior-citizen center for seniors in our community, classrooms for adult education programs for professional development, a day care center for infants and toddlers and a commercial-sized kitchen for serving residents of the county. The building is in the last phase of completion and we are seeking funding to be able to finish the project to serve the community.
