**Anne Arundel County – Operation of Vessels in Controlled Water Ski Area in
Maynadier Creek – Sunset Repeal**

This bill repeals the May 31, 2023 termination date of Chapter 747 of 2019 that created the Maynadier Creek controlled water ski area.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The Department of Natural Resources can continue to enforce the provisions of Chapter 747 using existing resources. Revenues are not affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 747 of 2019 authorizes a person to operate or give permission to operate a vessel for the purpose of towing a water skier in a slalom ski course located in a controlled water ski area in Maynadier Creek on (1) Mondays and Thursdays between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.; (2) Tuesdays and Wednesdays between 8 a.m. and sunset; (3) Fridays between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.; or (4) Sundays between 8 a.m. and noon. A person is prohibited, however, from operating or giving permission to operate a vessel for the purpose of towing a water skier in a slalom ski course located in a controlled water ski area in Maynadier Creek on Saturdays or State holidays.

Pursuant to current law, these provisions terminate May 31, 2023.
