Senate Bill 346

(Chair, Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee)(By Request - Departmental - Natural Resources)

Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Department of Natural Resources - Public Notices and Hearings

This departmental bill modifies various requirements under State fisheries laws and the State Boat Act relating primarily to publication of notices and to public hearings. The bill repeals or replaces numerous requirements for publication of notice in newspapers and repeals certain hearing requirements. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2021.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: General/special fund expenditures decrease by approximately \$20,000 annually, beginning in FY 2022. Revenues are not affected.

Background: DNR indicates that publishing legal notices in newspapers has become an expensive, inefficient method of reaching affected parties. The department currently also provides the notices on its website, as well as on social media accounts and through constituent email lists and text message lists, methods which it indicates are more effective in reaching affected individuals than the legal notice section of newspapers and less expensive. DNR indicates that it does not issue notices every year under all the statutes listed in the bill. The most commonly used provisions are for crab regulations, aquaculture leases, harvest reserve areas, and boating regulations.

State Fiscal Effect: General/special fund expenditures decrease by approximately \$20,000 annually, beginning in fiscal 2022, reflecting an approximate decrease each fiscal year of \$15,000 in costs for publishing notices in newspapers and \$5,000 in costs for hearings.
