AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 630
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after “Hester,” insert “Elfreth,”; in the same line, strike “Elfreth,”; in the same line, strike “and”; in the same line, after “Carter” insert “and Lam”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 6 down through “purposes;” in line 12 and substitute “requiring the Office of Resilience to coordinate with appropriate State agencies and State entities to meet certain goals;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 18, strike “**DEVELOP**” and substitute “**IDENTIFY**”.

On page 4, in line 13, after “**FROM**” insert “**APPROPRIATE**”; strike beginning with “**AS**” in line 13 down through “**SECTION**” in line 14; in line 15, strike “**IMPLEMENT STATE PROGRAMS**” and substitute “**IMPROVE INTERAGENCY COORDINATION**”; in line 18, strike “**ELIMINATING**” and substitute “**MINIMIZING**”; strike beginning with “**AND**” in line 22 down through “**POVERTY**” in line 23; in line 24, strike “**DESIGNING**” and substitute “**IMPROVING**”; in line 26, after “**SALINIZATION;**” insert “**AND**”; and strike in its entirety line 27.

On page 5, in line 1, strike “**(9)**” and substitute “**(8)**”.

On pages 5 through 7, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 3 on page 5 through line 30 on page 7, inclusive.

On page 8, in line 1, strike “**(11)**” and substitute “**(B)**”; in lines 3, 4, 7, and 9, strike “**(I)**”, “**(II)**”, “**(III)**”, and “**(IV)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(1)**”, “**(2)**”, “**(3)**”, and “**(4)**”, respectively; in lines 11, 13, 16, and 18, strike “**1.**”, “**2.**”, “**3.**”, and “**4.**”, respectively, and substitute “**(I)**”, “**(II)**”, “**(III)**”, and “**(IV)**”, respectively; in line 21, after the comma,

insert “That it is the intent of the General Assembly that State agencies and entities coordinate and cooperate with the Office of Resilience to carry out strategies and programs related to resilience.
