# <u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 233</u> (First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "**License**" insert "<u>and Licenses in the Town of</u> <u>Kensington</u>"; in line 6, after "Commission;" insert "<u>increasing the number of alcoholic</u> <u>beverages licenses that the Board of License Commissioners for Montgomery County is</u> <u>authorized to issue in the Town of Kensington;</u>"; in line 10, after "25–102" insert "<u>and</u> <u>25–1604(a)</u>"; and in line 15, after "25–405" insert "<u>and 25–1604(c) and (g)</u>".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 10, insert:

"<u>25–1604.</u>

(a) This section applies only to Kensington.

(c) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the Board may issue, in aggregate, not more than [eight] **20** Class A–K (off–sale) beer and wine licenses.

(2) <u>The Board, by majority vote, may issue one additional Class A–K</u> beer and wine license if there is:

- (i) <u>a public hearing before the town council; and</u>
- (ii) <u>a subsequent request made by the town council.</u>

(3) <u>A Class A–K beer and wine license holder may sell beer and wine for</u> <u>off–premises consumption Monday through Sunday, from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.</u>

(g) <u>The Board may issue, in aggregate, not more than [eight]</u> 20 licenses from among the following types:

- (1) <u>a Class B–K beer and wine license;</u>
- (2) <u>a Class B–K beer, wine, and liquor license;</u>
- (3) <u>a Class BD–BWL license;</u>
- (4) <u>a Class C beer and wine license;</u>
- (5) <u>a Class D–K beer license;</u>
- (6) <u>a Class D–K beer and wine license; and</u>
- (7) <u>a Class H beer and wine license.</u>".
