# <u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1253</u> (First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after "agreements;" insert "<u>clarifying the application of</u> <u>certain requirements to certain premises;</u>"; in line 11, strike "and"; and in the same line, after "1-321" insert "<u>, and 4-505(b)(1)</u>".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, after line 16, insert:

"4-505.

(b) (1) This section applies to:

(i) <u>a [licensed] premises [that sells] LICENSED TO SELL</u> alcoholic beverages [to a customer from a bar or service bar on the premises] FOR ON– PREMISES CONSUMPTION;

(ii) <u>a premises licensed to sell alcoholic beverages for off</u><u>premises consumption; and</u>

(iii) an unlicensed establishment in a jurisdiction that requires a worker, a supervisor, or an owner of an unlicensed establishment to receive alcohol awareness training.".
