## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "<u>Maryland Department</u> of Health – Secretary and Deputy Secretaries – Qualifications"; in line 4, after "education;" insert "<u>requiring each deputy secretary in the Maryland Department of</u> <u>Health to have certain professional qualifications;</u>"; in the same line, after "Health" insert "<u>and the deputy secretaries in the Maryland Department of Health</u>"; and in line 7, after "2–102" insert "<u>and 2–103(a)</u>".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 13, insert:

## "<u>2–103.</u>

(a) (1) With the approval of the Governor, the Secretary shall appoint the following five deputy secretaries:

- (i) <u>The Deputy Secretary for Behavioral Health;</u>
- (ii) The Deputy Secretary for Health Care Financing;
- (iii) The Deputy Secretary for Operations;
- (iv) The Deputy Secretary for Public Health Services; and
- (v) <u>The Deputy Secretary for Developmental Disabilities.</u>

(2) (I) EACH DEPUTY SECRETARY MUST HAVE AT LEAST 5 YEARS OF MANAGEMENT EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD THE DEPUTY SECRETARY WILL OVERSEE AS DEPUTY SECRETARY.

(II) <u>THE DEPUTY SECRETARY FOR PUBLIC HEALTH</u> <u>SERVICES MUST BE A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER LICENSED UNDER THE</u> <u>HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.</u>

[(2)] (3) The deputy secretaries serve at the pleasure of the Secretary.

[(3)] (4) The deputy secretaries are entitled to the salary provided in the State budget.

[(4)] (5) The deputy secretaries have the duties provided by law or delegated by the Secretary.".
