On page 1, in line 2, before "**Bay Restoration Fund**" insert "<u>Wastewater and</u> <u>Graywater – Use and Treatment and the</u>"; in lines 2 and 3, strike "– Intended Use Plans and Privately Owned Wastewater Facilities"; in line 4, after the first "of" insert "<u>authorizing the use of a certain graywater system to serve a public or private</u> <u>building in certain locations under certain circumstances; requiring the owner or</u> <u>operator of a building using a graywater system to safely dispose of graywater in a</u> <u>certain manner;</u>"; and strike beginning with "funding" in line 15 down through "facilities" in line 16 and substitute "<u>the use and treatment of graywater and wastewater</u> <u>and the Bay Restoration Fund</u>".

On page 2, in line 4, strike "9-1605(f)" and substitute "9-1112.1, 9-1605(f),".

(II) <u>A HOLDING TANK USED TO COLLECT AND STORE</u> POTABLE WATER.

(4) <u>"HANDWASHING SINK" MEANS A SINK USED FOR</u> <u>HANDWASHING ONLY.</u>

(B) <u>A GRAYWATER SYSTEM MAY BE USED TO SERVE A PUBLIC OR</u> PRIVATE BUILDING THAT:

(1) IS LOCATED ON A FORMER DREDGE SITE; OR

(2) (I) IS LOCATED IN A REMOTE AREA WITH MINIMAL PUBLIC ACCESS; AND

(II) OPERATES ON A SEASONAL BASIS.
