AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "**and West**" and substitute "<u>West</u>, <u>Klausmeier, and Benson</u>"; in lines 3 and 7, in each instance, strike "dispense" and substitute "<u>offer</u>"; in line 7, after "circumstances;" insert "<u>requiring the Maryland</u> <u>Department of Health to purchase and provide naloxone to certain providers, subject to a certain limitation; authorizing certain entities to provide naloxone only under certain <u>circumstances;</u>"; in line 10, strike "dispensing" and substitute "<u>offering</u>"; and in line 18, after "8–408" insert "<u>and 13–3103(d)</u>".</u>

On page 2, in line 3, strike "13–3104, 13–3108," and substitute "<u>13–3108</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 18, strike "DISPENSE" and substitute "OFFER".

On page 3, in lines 7 and 8, strike ": (I) A" and substitute "<u>A</u>"; strike beginning with the semicolon in line 8 down through "PROGRAM" in line 11; in line 13, strike "HUMAN SERVICES" and substitute "<u>HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT</u>"; strike beginning with "IN" in line 15 down through "7.01.19.01" in line 16; in line 24, strike "COMAR 10.47.02.11" and substitute "<u>REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE</u> <u>DEPARTMENT</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 25 through 27, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 1, strike "**DISPENSE OR MAKE AVAILABLE**" and substitute "<u>**OFFER**</u>"; and after line 4, insert:

"(C) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2023, EACH OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAM AND EACH INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAM SHALL HAVE A

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PROTOCOL TO OFFER NALOXONE, FREE OF CHARGE, WHEN AN INDIVIDUAL RECEIVES SERVICES FROM THE OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAM OR INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAM.

(D) **ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2024:**

(1) STATE AND LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES SHALL HAVE A PROTOCOL TO OFFER NALOXONE, FREE OF CHARGE, TO SENTENCED INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE AN OPIOID USE DISORDER OR WHO ARE AT RISK OF EXPERIENCING A DRUG OVERDOSE BEFORE THE INDIVIDUAL'S RELEASE; AND

(2) THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION SHALL HAVE A PROTOCOL TO OFFER NALOXONE, FREE OF CHARGE, TO INDIVIDUALS UNDER SUPERVISION WHO HAVE AN OPIOID USE DISORDER OR ARE AT RISK OF EXPERIENCING A DRUG OVERDOSE.

(E) <u>THE SECRETARY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS</u> <u>SECTION.</u>".

<u>AMENDMENT NO. 3</u>

On page 4, after line 9, insert:

"<u>13–3103.</u>

(D) (1) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THE STATE BUDGET, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PURCHASE AND PROVIDE NALOXONE, AT NO COST, TO THE PROVIDERS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO OFFER NALOXONE UNDER § 8–408 OR § 19– 310.3 OF THIS ARTICLE. SB0394/223422/01Finance CommitteeAmendments to SB 394Page 3 of 3

(2) <u>AN ENTITY REQUIRED TO OFFER NALOXONE UNDER § 8–408 OR</u> § 19–310.3 OF THIS ARTICLE MAY PROVIDE THE NALOXONE ONLY IF THE NALOXONE IS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT.";

and strike in their entirety lines 10 through 23, inclusive.

On page 5, in line 25, strike "**2024**" and substitute "<u>**2023**</u>"; and in the same line, strike "**DISPENSING**" and substitute "<u>**OFFERING**</u>".

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 29 on page 5 through line 3 on page 6, inclusive.
