# <u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 325</u> (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Washington" and substitute "<u>Washington, Bhandari, Chisholm, Hill, Johnson, Kerr, Kipke, Landis, R. Lewis, Pena-Melnyk, Pendergrass, Saab, and K. Young</u>"; in line 2, strike "**and Local**"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 3 down through "invoice;" in line 5; in line 6, strike "the State owes interest on unpaid amounts and"; in the same line, after "on" insert "<u>certain</u>"; in line 7, after "unpaid" insert "<u>procurement contract</u>"; strike beginning with "repealing" in line 7 down through "payments;" in line 8 and substitute "<u>requiring the Department of Legislative Services to submit a certain report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date;"; in line 9, strike "and local governments"; strike in their entirety lines 11 through 15, inclusive; and in line 18, strike "15–103 through 15–105" and substitute "<u>15–104</u>".</u>

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 23 on page 1 through line 4 on page 2, inclusive.

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 6 through 11, inclusive; in line 17, strike "**15**" and substitute "<u>37</u>"; in line 18, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike "**16TH**".

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 2 through line 1 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That, on or before December 1, 2022, the Department of Legislative Services shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on:

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(1)for each unit of State government:

the number of unit staff whose work responsibilities involve (i) processing procurement contract payments;

(ii) the number of vacancies for positions that would be assigned to process procurement contract payment; and

- for at least the prior 3 fiscal years: (iii)
- the average time for the unit to process a procurement 1.

contract payment;

are:

2. the percentage of procurement contract payments that

А. paid within 30 days after the day on which the payment becomes due under the procurement contract;

paid after 30 days but less than 37 days after the day В. on which the payment becomes due under the procurement contract;

С. paid after 37 days but less than 45 days after the day on which the payment becomes due under the procurement contract; and

D. paid 45 days or more after the day on which the payment becomes due under the procurement contract; and

the amount of interest paid by the unit for late 3. payments made on procurement contract invoices;

(2)based on the information obtained under item (1) of this section, the fiscal impact to the State of:

reducing the number of days following receipt of an invoice (i) after which the State owes interest on unpaid amounts; and

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(ii) reducing the number of days following receipt of an invoice after which interest begins to accrue on unpaid amounts; and

(3) the status of the upgrade of the Comptroller's online payment processing portal.";

and strike lines 2 and 3 in their entirety and substitute:

"<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 2023.

<u>SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in</u> <u>Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.</u>".
