AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 206
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after “Fund;” insert “requiring the Department of Agriculture to report on or before a certain date, to the General Assembly;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 1, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before October 1, 2022, the Department of Agriculture shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on the Spay/Neuter Fund, including:

(1) spay and neuter programs that are not receiving funding from the Spay/Neuter Fund;

(2) the market capacity for increasing the fees assessed on each brand name or product name of commercial feed under § 2–1603 of the Agriculture Article;

(3) a proposed fee structure that can be implemented over the next 5 to 10 years to enhance the revenue generated from the fees assessed under § 2–1603 of the Agriculture Article; and

(4) additional sources of revenue for the Spay/Neuter Fund.”;

and in line 2, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
