### AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1219

(First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "and" insert "Study on"; in line 3, after "altering" insert "a"; in the same line, strike "definitions" and substitute "definition"; in lines 4 and 5, strike "health care malpractice claims," and substitute "the"; in line 5, strike ", and HIV testing"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 5 down through "pharmacist" in line 11 and substitute "requiring the Maryland Insurance Commissioner to establish a workgroup to identify options and requirements necessary for the reimbursement of pharmacists and submit a report to certain committees on or before a certain date"; strike in their entirety lines 12 through 21, inclusive; and strike beginning with ", 15-148(c)" in line 24 down through "18–338.2(a)(3)" in line 25.

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 6 through 15, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 18 through 28, inclusive.

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 1 on page 3 through line 22 on page 4, inclusive, and substitute:

# "SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Insurance Commissioner shall:

- (1) establish a workgroup with representatives of pharmacists, carriers, managed care organizations, and other stakeholders, as appropriate, to identify options and requirements necessary for the reimbursement of pharmacists who provide medical services within their:
- (i) scope of practice as provided for in Title 12 of the Health Occupations Article; and

## (ii) work setting; and

(2) on or before December 31, 2022, report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, on the Commissioner's findings and recommendations.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2022.".
