AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1349
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate Henson**” and substitute “**Delegates Henson, Atterbeary, C. Branch, Charles, Ebersole, Feldmark, Griffith, Ivey, D. Jones, Lisanti, Luedtke, Patterson, and Wilkins**”; in line 2, strike “**Workgroup and Bonus**” and substitute “**Bonus and Report**”; strike beginning with “establishing” in line 3 down through “Professionals,” in line 4; in line 6, after “year;” insert “requiring the State Department of Education to collect certain data from each county board of education for a certain school year and to report the data on or before a certain date;”; and strike beginning with the first “the” in line 6 down through the comma in line 7.

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 10 on page 1 through line 20 on page 3, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with “If” in line 21 down through “the” in line 22 and substitute “In this section, “noncertificated education support professionals” means noncertificated public school employees designated as part of a bargaining unit under Title 6, Subtitle 5 of the Education Article.”

(b) The”;

in line 24, strike “sufficient” and substitute “equal to the number of noncertificated education support professionals, collected in accordance with subsection (c) of this section, multiplied by \$500, in order”; strike in their entirety lines 26 through 30, inclusive, and substitute:

“(c) The State Department of Education shall:

(1) collect data from each county board of education, including Baltimore City, on the number of noncertificated education support professionals the county board employed during the 2021–2022 school year; and

(2) on or before September 15, 2022, submit a report to the Governor, the Department of Budget and Management, and the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, on the total number of noncertificated education support professionals employed by county boards of education during the 2021–2022 school year.”;

and in line 31, strike “3.” and substitute “2.”; and strike beginning with “Section” in line 32 down through the period in line 34.
