BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - State Finance and Procurement 16-203.A PERSON SHALL BE DEBARRED FROM ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE STATE FOR A PERIOD OF 5 YEARS FOLLOWING THE ISSUANCE OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER BY THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW BOARD OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR THAT FINDS THAT, IN VIOLATION OF FEDERAL EXECUTIVE ORDER 11246, AS AMENDED, THE PERSON HAS ENGAGED IN DISCRIMINATORY HIRING PRACTICES IN THE STATE. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
