THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL 1 (2) $\mathbf{2}$ SUPPORT TO LICENSED CHILD CARE PROVIDERS IN THE STATE THAT ARE IN 3 DANGER OF CLOSING IN THE NEXT 12 MONTHS DUE TO FINANCIAL HARDSHIP.
