## Agriculture - Right to Engage in Equine Activities

FOR the purpose of stating the findings of the General Assembly relating to equine activities; declaring the intent of the General Assembly that residents of the State have a right to engage in equine activities subject to regulations and restrictions under laws enacted by the General Assembly; and generally relating to the right to engage in equine activities.

Section 2-702.2
Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2021 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

> Article - Agriculture

2-702.2.
(A) The GENERAL AsSEMBLY FINDS THAT:
(1) EQUINE ACTIVITIES ARE A VALUED PART OF THE STATE'S HISTORICAL, CULTURAL, AND SOCIAL HERITAGE THAT PROVIDE UNIQUE RECREATIONAL BENEFITS TO RESIDENTS OF THE STATE; AND
(2) Equine activities play an important part in the State's ECONOMY BY CONTRIBUTING TO LOCAL ECONOMIES, TAX REVENUES, AND

1 EMPLOYMENT, AND SUPPORT THE CONSERVATION, PRESERVATION, AND 2 MANAGEMENT OF THE STATE'S OPEN SPACE AND NATURAL RESOURCES USING 3 PRIMARILY PRIVATE DOLLARS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2022.
