1 (4) [\$40] **\$60** for service of process papers arising out of administrative 2 agency proceedings where the party requesting the service is a nongovernmental entity.

3 (5) For the sale following the execution or attachment of personal property: 4 Three percent of the first \$5,000; two percent of the second \$5,000; and one percent of any 5 amount in excess of \$10,000. The sheriff shall collect a minimum of \$15 and a maximum of 6 \$500 under the provisions of this paragraph.

7 (6) For the sale following the execution or attachment of real property: One 8 and one-half percent of the first \$5,000; one percent of the second \$5,000; and one-half of 9 one percent of any amount in excess of \$10,000. The sheriff shall collect a minimum of \$1.50 10 and a maximum of \$250 under the provisions of this paragraph.

11 (7) \$60 for service of a paper originating from a foreign court.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2022.
