## 2 Marine Contractor License - Performance of Services - Licensing Requirements 3 and Fees

- 4 FOR the purpose of exempting an individual employed by a county or municipality in the State who performs marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties 5 6 of their employment from paying a fee for the issuance or renewal of a marine 7 contractor license or a test administered by the Marine Contractors Licensing Board; 8 authorizing an individual employed by a county or municipality in the State to 9 perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties of their 10 employment without having to obtain a marine contractor license under certain 11 circumstances; and generally relating to marine contractor licenses and fees.

**(2)** 1 Solicit to perform marine contractor services in the State. 2 (b) An individual or an entity may qualify for a license. 3 An individual who is employed by an agency of the federal government or the State may perform marine contractor services while in the performance of the duties of 4 their employment without having to obtain a license from the Board under this title. 5 6 A residential or commercial property owner may perform marine contractor 7 services on the property owner's own property without having to obtain a license from the 8 Board under this title. THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR OF A TIDAL 22 IMPOUNDMENT DIKE, AN AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE DITCH, A HIGHWAY DRAINAGE 23DITCH, A ROADSIDE DRAINAGE DITCH, OR AN OUTLET FOR A ROADSIDE DRAINAGE DITCH; OR 242. 25ANY OTHER MARINE CONTRACTOR SERVICE THAT 26 THE BOARD DETERMINES WOULD PRESENT A DE MINIMIS RISK TO HUMAN HEALTH 27 OR THE ENVIRONMENT. 28 (II)IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS PERFORMING MARINE CONTRACTOR 29 SERVICES FOR THE ROUTINE MAINTENANCE OR REPAIR OF AN EXISTING SHORE 30 EROSION CONTROL STRUCTURE, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL OBTAIN A LICENSE FROM THE BOARD UNDER THIS TITLE. 31
