# Natural Resources - Healing Hunting and Fishing Fund - No-Cost Licenses and Stamps

FOR the purpose of authorizing an eligible sponsor organization providing recreational
opportunities with grant funding from the Healing Hunting and Fishing Fund to
provide at no cost an angler's license and trout stamps, a Chesapeake Bay and
coastal sport fishing license, or a hunting license and any corresponding stamps to
certain persons; and generally relating to the Healing Hunting and Fishing Fund.
