15	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "RODENT HARBORAGE" MEANS A CONDITION THAT:

9	(2) (I) CREATES OR CONTRIBUTES TO PROPERTY DAMAGE;
20 21	(II) IS INJURIOUS TO PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, OR THE WELFARE OF PROPERTY OWNERS: OR

- 1 (III) OBSTRUCTS THE REASONABLE USE OF PROPERTY.
- 2 (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
 3 NUISANCE ACTION FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY RODENT HARBORAGE ON REAL
 4 PROPERTY MAY BE BROUGHT AGAINST AN OWNER OF THE PROPERTY.
- 5 (2) A NUISANCE ACTION MAY NOT BE BROUGHT UNDER THIS 6 SUBSECTION IF THE RODENT HARBORAGE OCCURS ON PROPERTY ZONED FOR 7 AGRICULTURAL USE.
- 8 (C) THE COURT MAY AWARD COMPENSATORY AND PUNITIVE DAMAGES TO A 9 PREVAILING PLAINTIFF UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 10 **(D)** THE RIGHTS AND REMEDIES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION ARE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER RIGHTS OR REMEDIES THAT MAY EXIST AT LAW OR IN EQUITY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2022.
